## Meeting of Associations Webinar

At the Meeting of Associations in Amsterdam, the group thought that it would be advantageous to meet more than once a year.

On September 22, 2016, we did just that as 13 individuals from around the world joined together to touch base. The Board updated the group about the status of the new website and the upcoming conference in Bergamo. Then, Lydia Bose of Germany showed us the questionnaire and database, filled in with info from various National Associations. Lilian Beeks-Vergroesen of Holland sent the group information about the European Qualification Framework, saying "It is a Framework in which qualifications for any kind of education for certain professions (so also to be used for Kinesiology) can be compared between nations. The European Qualifications Framework (EQF) acts as a translation device to make national qualifications more readable across Europe, promoting workers' and learners' mobility between countries and facilitating their lifelong learning. The EQF aims to relate different countries' national qualifications systems to a common European reference framework."

As this subject requires in depth conversation, we would suggest all Associations participating in the Meeting in Bergamo April 27 & 28, 2017 take a look and discuss the framework before attending.
